*** GREAT NEW STUFF ***

Warm weather is in full swing! That can only mean it's time to knit and crochet cool and airy silhouettes in your favorite summer fibers. Here are the latest yarns and project ideas from our collection to get your wardrobe ready for those hazy, lazy, crazy days of summer -- to make and to wear! Take a look at our summertime essentials and beyond...

Knitted lace derives its delicacy from openings in the knitted fabric created by yarn-overs paired with corresponding decreases. Most knitted lace patterns place the yarn-overs and decreases close together. In one group of lace patterns, called Delayed Decrease patterns, the yarn-overs occur together and then the decreases occur together. The best known of these patterns is Old Shale, said to be one of the first true Shetland patterns found in lace shawls from the Shetland Islands from around 1836. Kathy's latest design links us to those wind-swept islands and the knitters of long ago in a new way. Everything old is new again. *Catch The Wave* (\$5.00 pattern, shown upper left) is a child's jacket with stockinette yoke and sleeves, and featuring an openwork body and cuffs. Worked in one piece to the underarms, the jacket is sized from baby to girls' 10/12. Our shop model was knit with DREAM IN COLOR "Cosette" (\$32.50, 4 oz., 270 yards, 70% superwash merino wool / 20% cashmere / 10% nylon, CYCA #3), a hand-dyed merino and cashmere blend...

According to Heather Zoppetti, TNNA Yarn Group Chair: "This summer, color is making a splash. Pops of bright color are still hot and you'll see flashes of neon -- especially green -- against neutrals". Enter "Uneek Cotton" by URTH YARNS (\$26.50, 100 grams, 275 yards, 100% mercerized cotton, CYCA #3), a vibrant, artisan hand-dyed wonder. Each skein is a work of art with a truly unique self-striping, clean, elegant timeless beauty. With your purchase of this yarn, receive a free shawl pattern for a garter stitch asymmetrical crescent-shaped shawl made with just one skein! Ask to see our work-in-progress...

Heather continues: "The big thing this season, though? Tie-dye. Tropical colors swirl into unexpected and fun shapes. Think about how you can incorporate these saturated colors into your wardrobe, your crafting and your home to bring some cheer and joy into the scorching summer months". Stay on-trend this summer with machine-washable PLYMOUTH "Fantasy Naturale" (\$9.50, 100 grams, 140 yards, 100% cotton mercerized, CYCA #4) for color-splashed projects that look almost like a beach party on your needles and hooks...

UNIVERSAL YARNS "Major" (\$12.00, 200 grams, 328 yards, 100% acrylic, CYCA #5) is majorly amazing! Each generous ball gives you outstanding color and yardage in each skein of lovely self-striping color that mixes and matches a spectrum of shades. This super soft acrylic is machine washable, and is super-quick stitching for a variety of knit and crochet projects from baby sweaters to garments to oversized shawls to colorful afghans!

We can always turn to Berroco for beautiful workhorse yarns like "Pima 100" (\$10.50, 100 grams, 219 yards, 100% pima cotton, CYCA #4). Four plies of pure, long-staple Peruvian cotton are tightly spun together in this light worsted weight yarn. The result produces a lightweight, washable and wonderfully wearable smooth fabric with a solid durability that's wonderful for a busy summer. The CHURCHMOUSE CLASSICS folks recommend this as a natural choice for their *Sideways Tee* pattern (\$12.50). Relaxed, yet sporty, it's a hand-knit nod to "athleisure" wear. Cleverly knit from the center out to each side, rather than top to bottom, this sweater is a modern pivot to a familiar style. A tapered shape allows for plenty of ease at the bust, while providing an easy, flattering hem at hip length...



*** MORE GREAT NEW STUFF ***

Looking for a clever, breezy top to beat the heat in style? *Tidewater* (\$6.00 Ravelry Pro download, shown right) is a lightweight summer tee that is easy to knit and easy to wear. Construction begins with the upper back. Shoulder stitches are then picked up and each front shoulder is knit while shaping the neckline. Front and back are joined in the round at the underarms. The tee is knit inside out so that no purling is required for the reverse stockinette body. Cap sleeves are finished as you go with the same I-cord trim that edges the back vent. Shadow rib at the shoulders and hem adds a bit of interest to the knitting and wearing.

We recommend DRAGONFLY FIBERS "Dance Rustic Silk" yarn for this project, a fingering weight 100% silk plied semi-solid hand dyed yarn coming soon to our shelves. We are also anticipating the arrival of a limited edition cowl kit in this fiber with colorway *Springtime in Washington*. We are pleased to announce that a DRAGONFLY FIBERS Trunk show will be at Kathy's Kreations throughout the Steel Valley Yarn Crawl August 2 - 11, 2019. It promises to be an exciting summer with wonderful new products for your stitching pleasure...

Our friends at CHURCHMOUSE CLASSICS tell us: "Any activity that keeps our hands busy -- and fills them with yarn -- makes us happy. And we've been falling in love with crochet for years! Its versatility offers the freedom to combine a few simple stitches into an endless variety of textures and patterns. The firmly locked stitches provide *oomph* to pieces that need a sturdy structure -- like baskets, bags, slippers, and more!"

"The thicker, heavier fabric that crochet produces is perfect for the *Oval Crocheted Bucket Bags & Pouches* (\$8.00 pattern). This series of bags echoes a capacious 'bucket' shape with an oval base for less bulky proportions". Both bucket bags can be made with either backpack or drawstring straps. Two sizes of zippered pouches are customizable -- simply keep crocheting until you've reached the size you like!

PLYMOUTH YARNS "Hannah" (\$8.50, 100 grams, 175 yards, 65% cotton/35%bamboo, CYCA #4) is an "a-durable" cotton/bamboo blend. Soft and buttery, yet still very pigmented, this easy care Aran weight is an excellent choice for summer tops and heirloom baby blankets...

ANZULA YARNS is a California-based company that specializes in hand-dyed luxury fibers that create yarns with a soft touch and eye-catching colorways. Are you looking to knit with a new and *different* yarn? ANZULA's newest, "Dottie", is for you (\$34.50, 100 grams, 420 yards, 80% superwash merino / 17% acrylic / 3% polyester, CYCA #2)! There is a tweedy effect created by the neps of black acrylic that results in a very unique fabric. We have a limited supply of gold with black just in time for Steeler training camp...

A trend noted at the TNNA Show is not as obvious as color or design -- it's about source. Knitters and crocheters want to know where items are made, where the fiber comes from, who does the work, and where the money goes. The aim of the World Fair Trade Organization is to bring economic and social opportunities to women in communities abroad. MANOS DEL URUGUAY, *The Hands of Uruguay*, is a non-profit, fair trade organization which assembles women in cooperatives throughout the countryside of Uruguay to kettle dye its yarns. Each skein is labeled with the location and the artisan who hand-dyed that particular skein. Fresh supplies of MANOS DEL URUGUAY "Maxima" (\$20.50 100 grams, 219 yards, 100% extrafine merino, CYCA #4) are here! Super-soft merino fiber and a light single-ply construction make "Maxima" a cuddly yarn. With its popular worsted weight gauge, you'll find plenty of uses for this yarn from scarves to sweaters to hats, cowls and more!

Our July 2019 KAL choice, *April Flowers Cowl* by designer Jenn Hendrix (\$6.00, Ravelry Pro download, shown left) with its cute flower embellishment, was recommended by one of our knitting friends, Linda H. She suggested it when she saw our new arrivals of URTH YARNS "Uneek Fingering".

Join us for fun summer knitting every Friday during July 2019 at Kathy's Kreations from 10:00 am - 2:00 pm for the group project (we've got air conditioning!), the continuation of previous KALs, or any other works in progress purchased here. If you can't join us in person, follow us on the Ravelry July 2019 shop thread at "We Love Kathy's"...

We can't resist joining in the *Perfect Blend MKAL* by designer CASAPINKA (see lower right), a tea-themed mystery KAL beginning July 8, 2019, and continuing for 6 weeks. This project features a kit of 12 gorgeous specially-customized mini-skeins from DREAM IN COLOR (\$125/ kit plus \$7.00 Ravelry Pro pattern download). Limited supplies of three color combinations are available in "Smoochy with Cashmere" -- Berry Blast, Earl Grey, and Apricot Green. Our in-shop knit along group project will kick off with a Cast-On Tea Party on Friday, July 12, 2019. This MKAL will include recipes from the designer, and we will have a few of our own as well with "samples" every Friday...

*** UPCOMING KNITTING CLASSES (call 724-238-9320 to register for all classes) ***

Colorwork can seem like a challenging task, but, luckily, instructor Karen McCullough will introduce you to a wonderful new knitting technique each month with panels from Michelle Hunter's *Building In Color* book. Join Karen as this series draws to its close on **Tuesday, July 2, 2019, 10:00 am - 12 noon** to learn *Blocking & Finishing* of the project. Registration fee is \$10 per class plus materials.

Karen is planning to offer *Building Blocks* class series starting in September -- check with us regarding dates and times!

In our series of lace classes, students will master lace knitting one section at a time. Join our instructor Kathy Erhard as she demonstrates lace skills and work along to make your own gorgeous lace shawl as a wearable showcase of your skills. Our next class is scheduled for **Saturday, July 13, 2019, from 9:00 am - 12:00 noon** at Kathy's Kreations. and will be held once a month. It's not too late to join the group and take your lace skills from casual to experienced as the series continues!

Texture knitting enthusiasts will really love this month's lace pattern, as Michelle Hunter's *Building With Lace* adds the Smocking Stitch to its repertoire of amazing lace stitches. Decorative Smocking Stitch can be used to change the width of knitting fabric, but in pattern its addition adds a bit of depth to the fabric while preserving the original width. Students are using the gorgeous HiKoo by Skacel RYLIE (50% baby alpaca/25% mulberry silk/25% linen) yarn, so see Kathy for this yarn or a suitable substitute and bring size 5 and 6 24" circular needles. No additional tools are required for this stitch pattern. The class fee is \$20 per session. Please call 724-238-9320 to register.

Back by popular demand, the *Afterthought Heel* sock class will show you how to give your socks afterthought heels, shape toes, work the Kitchener stitch, and weave in ends. The class is working on *Falling Dominoes Socks* with their cascading traveling stitches, but if you have other top-down socks already in progress, you can bring them instead with the cuff and leg already worked in Kathy's Kreations yarn. Join instructor Kathy Erhard on **Saturday, July 13, 2019, from 1:00 pm - 4:00 pm**. Class fee is \$20. Please call 724-238-9320 to register...

One of our roles as your local yarn store (LYS) is to educate and inform you of each season's key fashion trends, providing you with a wide range of project ideas, products and technical how-to's for successfully completing expressions of your creativity. At TNNA (National Needlework Association Trade Show) in Cleveland, OH last month, owner Kathy Z, instructor/tech editor Kathy Erhard, Facebook/Social Media consultant Vina McLeod Rudolph caught up with valued industry friends and colleagues, and made some new connections. Attending this show enables us to meet with other shop owners, designers and vendors. It's a wonderful opportunity to learn from each other and become inspired for future new products. We're working on a doozy of a collection for fall and winter. Some yarns and accessories are already on our shelves, while others will be arriving over the remainder of the summer, so stay in touch!

We explored amazing colors, textures, fibers & stitches at the Fashion Show, "Sample It!", the "New Products" display and the vendors' booths. The variety of products is always incredible and this year was no exception. When it comes to clothes, comfortable, oversized silhouettes continue to be on everyone's radar. Roomy, relaxed, generous and breezy are adjectives to best describe everything from shawls and ponchos to sweaters and skirts. Caitlin Hunter's sweater design, *Soldotna Cropped*, a Fair Isle yoke sweater, was everywhere (see upper right, Ravelry Pro download), so come in to see ours in progress with HiKOO "Kenzie" yarn. Hot shades included coral (the color of the year), lavender gray (the color of the fall season), and shades of teal, lime and aqua. Here's a sneak peek of what's coming:

Warm fuzzies -- downy and soft, irresistible yarns with a halo are trending for fall, according to *Yarn Market News*. Fluffy cashmere, kid mohair and baby alpaca gently heathered shades perfect for wardrobe staples like CHURCHMOUSE CLASSICS *Two Point Cowl*. Fuzzy yarns will be just the thing when the weather turns colder...

The SKACEL booth was wonderful, as always. Their display featured the *Zebra Fade* design from Kathy Erhard in HiKOO "Sueno" (now on display in our shop). We're expanding the *Simplicity* family with "Simplicity Spray". All seven new spray-dyed colorways in 200-gram cakes will be available at the end of summer. There will be less ends to weave in, less worries about dye lot matching, and more fun! "Cashmere Zauber" is a unique inclusion to the *Zauberball* line featuring the luxury of cashmere. Every ball is unique as not all colors will be found in all balls. This virgin merino wool from Patagonia is great for both sweaters and accessories.

Our upcoming schedule includes a knit along with Kyle Kunnecke featuring *Sueno* yarn and a stranded colorwork *Knit, Knit Cowl* in August; *Fan Dance* lace socks hosted by German designer "CraSy" Sylvie Rasch, inventor of the extremely popular FlexiFlips in September; and Michelle Hunter wraps up October with a Mystery Shawl Knit along with new "Simplicity Spray". Fun stuff is planned with SKACEL products -- please join us!

At the BRYSON DISTRIBUTING booth, we re-stocked CHIAGOO and KNITTER'S PRIDE needles and essential goodies. CHIAGOO has new interchangeable needle *Twist Shorties* sets with 2" & 3" tips in sizes 0 - 3 and 4 - 8. KNITTER'S PRIDE is introducing a line of *Smart Stix*, with cord and needle tips marked into 1" increments to help with measuring gauge. We are excited to introduce wrist rulers to our customers -- bracelets with ruler measurements for a handy tape measure at your fingertips! Our best new crochet find was the colorful PRYM crochet hooks, with an ergonomically-designed handle grip (shown lower left)...

With a sophisticated palette of colors, "Arno" is ideal for those timeless wardrobe staple pieces. New to us "Aero" is a light and lofty blend of alpaca, nylon and wool that works up quickly with larger knitting needles and crochet hooks. The vivid color combinations work perfectly with easy, simple projects...



Whether big or small, bags are a necessary accessory for every knitter and crocheter. Pack them up with a project and you're good to go anywhere. ATENTI has some new totes in versatile textile treatments like Buffalo Check and Mama Llama print (coming in later this summer!). Designed and handmade in America, ATENTI utilizes faux fur and faux leather in its bags...

At every show, we discover a new "gem". This year's can't-resist-it find is EMMA'S YARN. Emma began dyeing yarn in central Florida in 2016, at the age of 15, as part of a homeschool math and science project. She quickly learned that she loved doing it and had a knack for color. It wasn't long before Emma was selling her high quality yarn at her LYS (owned by her parents) and moved her production from the kitchen to a dye studio. After graduating college in December 2017, Aspen joined her sister in dyeing and development of the two sisters' business. We look forward to carrying their "crazy beautiful color" EMMA'S YARN which should arrive towards the end of summer...

If you're planning to knit or crochet something for the wee ones in your life, SIRDAR "Snuggly Baby Cashmere Merino DK" is a little bit of perfection. It has a beautifully soft blend of merino wool, acrylic and a touch of cashmere that will be comfortable on sensitive skins. It's machine-washable, too...

Good projects start with great yarn. MADELINETOSH is known for their great colorways and their yarns are some of the most gorgeous knitting and crochet yarns available. Using all natural fibers that are ethically sourced from mills around the world, MADELINETOSH YARNS are hand-dyed in Texas with low impact organic compound dyes, that are good for you and the Earth! New shades of their signature superwash merino wool base "Tosh Merino Light" will be arriving soon -- we hope that you'll find them as much of a joy to work with as we do!

New from MANOS DEL URUGUAY is "Alma", a fingering weight single-ply superwash merino in rich colorways. Look for new color gradient mini-skein bundles for Fino, in an enticing new packaging...

We were delighted to introduce MAB ELEMENTS handcrafted shawl pins and coordinated earring sets to our shop following the spring Pittsburgh Knit & Crochet Festival. Owner Michelle Barratt continues to come up with creative jewelry accessories combining hand-forged aluminum and semi-precious stones like the orange sodalite grouping (shown lower left) that are super lightweight and won't tarnish.
