It's getting cold outside here in the Laurel Highlands! Snow-flakes are starting to fly, and the ski slopes have opened earlier than usual. Winter has us craving the snuggly caress of knit afghans, sweaters, and hats. We are fascinated by rich textures like cables and lightweight chunky yarns that evoke a sense of comfort and joy. It's time to pull out our knitting needles and crochet hooks and stave off the bitter chill with some satisfying winter stitching. Stay warm and cozy with these great products for gift giving this holiday and beyond...

Join us in knitting the trendy AMBAH ADVENT 2019 KAL! Choose any of Ambah O'Brien's six yarn Advent-inspired designs like the *ADVENTuresome Wrap* (shown upper left), *ADVENTurous Wrap* or *ADVENTurer Wrap* (\$6.00 per each pattern available here as a Ravelry Pro download). This shawl was designed with a Yarn Advent Calendar in mind, to make the most of a daily mini-skein kit. There are so many possibilities -- add colors in randomly, arrange your minis in a gradient fade, or use a main color and alternate with mini-skeins. Simple garter stitch keeps this a mindless knit, while some fun shaping and regular color changes will keep you wanting to knit on. What adventure will you take with your Wrap?

DREAM IN COLOR has hand-dyed custom ADVENTuring KAL kits just for us, available with a full skein plus 24 minis in your choice of merino wool base yarns single-ply"Jilly" (\$75.50 mini kit plus \$24.50 full skein) or twist-plied "Smooshy" (\$97.50 mini kit plus \$26.50 full skein). Supplies are limited, but additional shipments are coming soon. Some even make special holiday gift socks for every member of their family to wear during their celebration. YARNS "Encore Chunky" (\$6.95, 100 grams, 143 yards; 75% acrylic / 25% wool, CYCA #5) for easy care and quick affordable knitting. Two other new patterns from LISA KNITS include AC-046 Cabled Keyhole Scarflet and AC-047 Mitered Pendant Necklace (\$5.00 each). Both are fast knits and are just the ticket for last-minute gift projects. Necklace kits include beads and sufficient yarn to make the project for \$5.00 each while supplies last. An ideal stash buster, the scarflet is just the right size to tuck inside a coat to ward off winter's chill...

Your perfect hat project is calling! Hats keep you a little warmer on your daily commute and are perfect for challenging hair days -- the ultimate winter wonders! Our favorite patterns and the ones that are "most knit" by customers include KATHY ERHARD DESIGNS "Classic Ribbed Hat" (\$5.00, Aran weight, sized from child to adult), CHURCHMOUSE CLASSICS "Mistake Stitch" (\$6.50, in worsted weight and chunky weight versions, average adult size, directions include matching scarf) and IRMIAN DESIGN "Lance Hat" (\$6.50, average adult size, in worsted and chunky weight versions). If you prefer stranded colorwork Fair Isle knitting, TIN CAN KNITS "Fleet" (\$6.95, Aran weight, sized from newborn to adult) is a colorful, cozy beanie. Add a "holly jolly" faux fur puff pompom for the "crowning" touch...

Need something a little special to slip into a stitcher's stocking this holiday season? Here are some great ideas for small gifts that all your fiber friends will love, or just some suggestions for little extras other people can get for you for the holidays (or your birthday).

- Measuring tape -- it never hurts to have more than one! You can keep one in each project bag or in the room of the house where knitting happens
- SUSAN BATES "Handi-Tool" (aka "cool tool") for picking up stitches and doing repairs
- LEE "Highlighter Tape" -- keep track of your pattern with this handy "on/off" tape
- KNITTER'S PRIDE "Knit Blockers" rust-resistant stainless steel pin tool
- Needle Keeper -- protect circular needle tips, joins and stitches
- Row counter -- you always need one for every project
- Stitch markers -- you never have enough & somehow they disappear into the furniture
- Cable needles -- these disappear too, ask about our new PRYM "Yoga" cable needle
- CLOVER Chibi tapestry finishing needles

The variations in colorways and creative color combinations are beautiful!

*** DECEMBER KNIT ALONG ***

Our December knitalong (KAL) features a colorful cozy cowl, *Morton,* by designer Cornelia Tuttle Hamilton (shown left). Knitting with two different yarn weights produces amazing texture in this comfy cowl! The slip stitch tweed piece is worked flat, then seamed. Select MANOS DEL URUGUAY "Alegria" and "Alegria

Grande", "Wool Classica" and "Fino", DREAM IN COLOR "Classy" and "Smooshy" or your choice of any wonderful yarn combinations from our shelves and let's get started on this stunning piece with a woven look that's much easier to knit than it appears!

Join us for knitting/ crocheting every Friday during December 2019 at Kathy's Kreations from 10:00 am - 2:00 pm for the group project, the continuation of previous KALs, or any other works in progress purchased here. Our weekday knitting class series based on books by Michelle Hunter and taught by instructor Karen McCullough continue during this month. Take your knitting to the next level with new skills. *Building With Lace* is scheduled for Tuesday, December 3, 2019; 9:30 am - 12:30 pm and focuses on *Cables and Lace*. The delicate nature of lace is a beautiful contrast to the bold impact of cables, and in combination, these patterns form some of the most stunning designs in lace knitting. Class registration is \$20.00 for the class plus purchase of book and yarn from Kathy's Kreations. AND, improve your knitting skills one square at a time with *Building Blocks*, designed to help knitters navigate through major knitting

techniques and principles. The recommended yarn is HiKOO "Simpliworsted", a lovely blend of superwash merino and premium acrylic/nylon that is very soft and durable. We continue the lessons by learning Simple Decreases. Depending on the method used to decrease, the new stitch will slant to the left or right. These two simple decreases are incorporated into the pattern learned in this session. The class is scheduled for Tuesday, December 3, 2019, from 1:00 pm - 3:00 pm. Registration fee is \$15.00 plus purchase of book and yarn from Kathy's Kreations...

In our ongoing series of lace classes, students will master lace knitting one section at a time. Join our instructor Kathy Erhard as she demonstrates lace skills and work along to make your own gorgeous lace shawl as a wearable showcase of your skills (photo lower right). This month's class adds a geometric design to *Building With Lace*. Strategically placed increases and decreases form a circular motif that knitters will be especially proud to knit and to wear. The combination of a circular motif lace pattern within a rectangular shawl is truly eye-catching.

Students are using the gorgeous HiKoo by Skacel RYLIE (50% baby alpaca, 25% mulberry silk, 25% linen) yarn, so see Kathy Z for this yarn or a suitable substitute. Join us on Saturday, December 7, 2019, from 9:00 am - 12 noon at Kathy's Kreations. The class fee is \$20 per session. Please call us at 724-238-9320 to register.

Sign up for the Christmas Ornament: Top-Down Mini Sock class and learn how to knit a basic sock worked from the top down, from cuff to toe. Instructor Kathy Erhard will explain how to choose appropriate yarn, work the cast on so that your sock will fit over your heel, work a heel gusset without holes, and understand the Kitchener stitch. You will leave the class with all the skills required to make an adult-sized pair of socks that will hug your feet with comfort. Please choose

Knitters who have never tried double-pointed needles will find instant success with this amazing innovation in knitting needles. You will also need a stitch marker and tapestry needle. *** CHRISTMAS STITCHING SONG ***


This little diddy was written by Connie, adapted by us, and is sung to the tune of "Up On The Housetop":

*** WELTED COWL ***

This is an easy knit, reversible cowl -- the ridge pattern looks lovely on either side! It also has potential as a stash buster. Our work in progress is shown at lower left. FINISHED SIZE: approximately 9" high x 26" around, one size fits an average adult MATERIALS: 150 yards worsted weight yarn (shown in WONDERLAND YARNS "March Hare"); US size 7 circular knitting needle 16" - 20" length; stitch marker

GAUGE: 20 sts / 36 rounds = 4" over welt pattern, slightly stretched. TAKE TIME TO SAVE TIME, CHECK YOUR GAUGE



DIRECTIONS: Cast on 130 stitches. Place marker and join for knitting in the round, being careful not to twist work.

Rounds 1 - 6: Purl Rounds 7 - 12: Knit.

Repeat these 12 rounds until piece measures approximately 9", ending with round 5. Bind off all stitches loosely as if to purl. Weave in ends and enjoy!
