This delightfully fit-for-royalty luxurious adornment soft blend fingering weight yarn can be used to make amazing shawls, accessories or wondrous "treat for your feet" socks. Hand-dyed yarns have subtle variations in colors that are natural and vary from skein to skein. New colorways are Sleeping Gyrphon, Contrariwise and Ireland from the De-Stitch Nation tour collection...

URTH YARNS "Uneek Cotton" (\$26.50, 100 grams, 275 yards, 100% mercerized cotton, CYCA #3) is a hand-dyed self-striping mercerized cotton in rich colors perfect for any maker's projects! This beautiful yarn is offered in a range of vibrant hues to calming earth tones guaranteed to give any project a "Uneek" look! For project ideas, think summer tops, scarves and shawls. For a limited time, get a free pattern with purchase of this yarn for an easy knitted or crocheted (your choice) shawllette that uses just one skein!

You will love the new DREAM IN COLOR Sock-It! Club sock sets (\$36.50, photo of the July club selection shown lower right). Now through November, we will be featuring bright, fun dip-dyed (so it stripes!) "Smoochy" sock yarn with a contrasting 100 yard heel-toe mini-skein. Sock knitting is very popular, especially in the summer months, when socks make the perfect portable project! EMMA'S YARN latest colorway *Mermaid Tavern* is a fun shade that will soon be here on base "Practically Perfect Sock" (\$26.95, 100 grams, 400 yards, 100% superwash merino, CYCA #2). This shade will make a cool pair of socks or a beautiful, drapery shawl with excellent stitch detail -- both projects will make great take-along stitching...

Here are some words of advice from TAHKI YARNS: "We're finally in heat wave season and it's time to break out the best of our tees and tanks. When looking for a good hot weather outfit, we like to find pieces crafted from a lightweight 100% cotton yarn". We echo this sentiment and are featuring some of our favorite tees, vests and tanks this month. *Circles Vest* (\$6.50, Ravelry Pro download, shown page 7, lower left) is a button-front sleeveless vest worked in one piece from the bottom up. This vest incorporates a deep V-neck, empire waist accented with the "circles" pattern, and curved front hems. Waist shaping decreases and increases, worked just before and after the waistband, flow into the "circles" pattern. Since the vest is worked even to the waistband, the vest length can be easily changed. Set-in pockets are accented with the "circles" pattern and finished with a ribbed edge, armholes and garment edges are also finished with the ribbed bands. Worked in a cotton like TAHKI "Cotton Classic" (\$7.50, 50 grams, 108 yards, 100% mercerized cotton, CYCA #3) or cotton/wool blend like BERROCO "Arno" (\$12.50, 50 grams, 159 yards, 57% cotton/43% merino wool), this garment can be worn year-round...

It seems like summer has just gotten here, but you will want to start early to be ready for sweater weather and beyond. BERROCO recently introduced its exciting new fall line up, with mohair and mohair carry-alongs having a moment. Here are the new yarns which will be arriving soon:

- *Tiramisu* (\$12.50, 50 grams, 137 yards, 38% wool/28% acrylic/23% superkid mohair/11% silk, CYCA #4) : If you married the beautiful color flow of *Millefiori* with the softness and halo of mohair like our new *Aerial*, you get *Tiramisu*. This is a light worsted weight wool, acrylic, mohair and silk blend. Colors flow from brights to darks to make a beautiful self-stripping fabric.
- *Artesia* (\$30.50, 100 grams, 475 yards, 40% alpaca/40% kid mohair/20% nylon, CYCA 5): This new chunky weight yarn is a blend of alpaca, kid mohair and nylon. Create accessories and garments that are soft, fuzzy and light with this unique hand dyed yarn. Use by itself or held together with another BERROCO classic workhorse yarn like "Ultra Wool" (\$12.50, 100 grams, 219 yards, 100% superwash wool, CYCA #4), "Sesame" or "Arno".
- *Aerial* (\$12.50, 25 grams, 284 yards, 65% superkid mohair/35% silk, CYCA #3, shown lower left): Airy and light, this new mohair and silk lace blend is a perfect yarn to carry along with any BERROCO basic yarn to give a soft halo to any project.
- *Coco* (\$20.50, 100 grams, 77 yards, 100% superwash merino wool, CYCA #6): Quickly make fun projects with this super-bulky weight yarn! BERROCO *Coco* is a crimped-look 100% superwash merino wool dyed with splashes of color for fast and fabulous projects.
- *Millefiori Light Luxe* (\$15.50, 100 grams, 350 yards, 50% acrylic/43% wool/6% nylon/1% other fiber, CYCA #3): Our *Millefiori Light Luxe* is just that subtle kiss of glam that you can give to all your favorite *Millefiori Light* projects (like our "Adriana" poncho on display). Colors ebb and flow in the *Millefiori Light* shimmer and shine yarn that you already love, but with a little sparkle. This subtle self-stripping sport weight yarn is perfect for summer projects too, as well as trans-seasonal dressing later.

We all love to knit something just a little lacy in the summer. Our knitting friend Ann P recently told us about one of her favorite patterns, *Paris By Day* from BAAH YARNS (\$6.00 Ravelry Pro download). She is so enthralled with it that she has made three so far, and has just cast on a fourth! This pattern is perfect for the intermediate knitter who is proficient with K2tog, ssk, and yarn overs. The shawl uses three skeins of fingering weight yarn -- try a cashmere blend for extra softness, loft and drape.

This is a one-size-fits-all rectangular stole with the flexibility of adding length by adding another skein of yarn. We are once again holding Friday knit alongs in the shop with limited RSVP occupancy, asking you to please mask up (face covering over mouth and nose), practice social distancing and use hand sanitizer. \*\*\* PENNSYLVANIA ROAD TRIP MYSTERY SHAWL KNIT-ALONG CONTINUES \*\*\*

A fun knit-along among PA yarn shops (and beyond) kicked off on Saturday, April 25, 2020 and runs through the end of August! Your "tour guides" are Cynthia Spencer of REALLY CLEAR DESIGNS / STITCH YOUR ART OUT and her techy friend Valerie Reed who have designed an exciting shawl that you can combine with retail therapy by visiting local yarn shops as health safety concerns permit! They are both experienced knitters with a love of beautiful yarn, local yarn shops, and the wonderful community of people that share our love of knitting. They have decided to take inspiration from the things they have seen and experienced while living and traveling in their home state of Pennsylvania to make a stunning shawl with a variety of stitch patterns. Every stitch pattern they've included is inspired by a shape or pattern or color they've seen in the beauty that surrounds us all.

So far, we have virtually "armchair visited" the following PA locales with the first 3 legs of our journey and were inspired by: either Centre Hall or State College, Bedford or Fallingwater, the Pittsburgh National Aviary or Presque Isle State Park, Erie.

Our continuing knitting class series based on books by Michelle Hunter and taught by instructor Karen McCullough continue. Take your knitting to the next level with new skills. *Building With Lace* is scheduled for **Tuesday, July 7, 2020; 9:30 am - 12:30 pm** and focuses on *Pattern Both Sides*. Lace fabric falls into two categories -- lace knitting or knitted lace. Decreases and increases must function together as pairs and remain in the correct placement and ratio to form the pattern. With knitted lace, decreases and increases are worked on both sides of the fabric. To maintain a visually consistent decrease line on the right side of the fabric, the decreases on the wrong side of the fabric must follow the same slant. Karen will demonstrate both left-leaning and right-leaning decreases. Class registration is \$20.00 for the class plus purchase of book and yarn from Kathy's Kreations.

AND, improve your knitting skills one square at a time with *Building Blocks*, designed to help knitters navigate through major knitting techniques and principles. The recommended yarn is HIKOO "Simpliworsted", a lovely blend of superwash merino and premium acrylic/nylon that is very soft and durable. We continue the lessons by learning *Left Twist*. Twists are extremely popular in Aran-style knitting and are incorporated into cable designs ranging from basic to very intricate patterns. Learning to execute a Left Twist opens the door to many gorgeous details. The class is scheduled for **Tuesday, July 7, 2020, from 1:00 pm - 3:00 pm**. Registration fee is \$15.00 plus purchase of book and yarn from Kathy's Kreations...

\*\*\* PINEAPPLE SUNSHINE CAKE \*\*\*

Our Friday knit alongs have resumed within limited capacity social distancing guidelines, with masks, hand sanitizer and frequent cleaning of hard surfaces. But, the good news is that we are safely getting together in a small group for this "new normal". Kathy baked a celebration cake to welcome back the group!



INGREDIENTS

CAKE: 1 box golden butter or yellow cake mix  
4 eggs  
1/2 cup vegetable oil  
one 8 oz. can crushed pineapple with juice

FROSTING: one 8 oz. container Cool Whip, thawed  
one small box instant vanilla pudding  
one 8 oz. can crushed pineapple with juice

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Preheat oven to 350 degrees. Spray a 13" X 9" pan with cooking spray.
2. In a large bowl, combine cake mix, eggs, oil, and one can of crushed pineapple with the juice. Mix well.
3. Pour into prepared baking pan and bake for 25 - 30 minutes, or until toothpick inserted into center of cake comes out clean. Allow to cool completely on a wire rack.
4. In a medium size bowl, fold together whipped topping, vanilla pudding, and one can crushed pineapple with juice. Spread over top of cooled cake. Enjoy!

\*\*\* "KATHY'S 'WE ARE' BLANKET" \*\*\*

We are hopeful that sports will resume again soon, and that college kids will be able to return to campuses again. It's time to show our team spirit. Kathy has designed a quick knit throw in a doubled strand of bulky weight yarn for upcoming kick-offs and send-offs (photo lower right). Choose your favorite team's two shades and finish it off with a neutral border.

FINISHED MEASUREMENT: approximately 50" wide X 64" long

YARN: 9 skeins EACH in 2 colors PLYMOUTH YARN "Forget Me Not" (100 grams, 136 yards, 100% cotton, CYCA #5); 2 skeins in contrasting color for border  
*shown in navy (A) color 10, white (B) color 1 and gray (C) color 5*

ACCESSORIES: US size 13 (9.00 mm) circular knitting needle 40" length; US Size M (9.00 mm) crochet hook for border; tapestry needle for weaving in ends

GAUGE: 10-1/2 stitches / 13 rows = 4" in Irish moss pattern stitch with US size 13 knitting needles; TAKE TIME TO SAVE TIME, CHECK YOUR GAUGE

NOTES: Blanket body is worked back & forth with two strands of yarn, one each color A & B. A long circular needle is used to accommodate stitches. Border is worked in single crochet with two strands of color C.

DIRECTIONS

Holding one strand each color A & B, cast on 130 stitches with long tail method or technique of choice. Work in Irish Moss pattern as follows (photo lower right):

Set-Up Row (WS): \*P1, k1; repeat from \* across.

Row 1: \*P1, k1; repeat from \* across.

Row 2: \*K1, p1; repeat from \* across.

Row 3: \*K1, P1; repeat from \* across.

Row 4: \*P1, k1; repeat from \* across.

Repeat rows 1 - 4 for pattern until piece measures 62" or desired length, ending with row 2 or 4. Bind off all stitches with a stretchy bind-off.

BORDER: With two strands C, work single crochet around all edges of blanket, working 3 single crochet stitches into each corner. Fasten off.

### \*\*\* FALL FLING WEEKEND 2020 \*\*\*

Kathy's Kreations invites you to join us our 11th annual "Fall Fling" Knitting Workshop Weekend, to be held **October 2 - 4, 2020**, hosted by Kathy Zimmerman. We are delighted to announce that TKGGA-certified Master Knitter and Technical Editor, Kathy Erhard of Export, PA will be our featured instructor (Kathy's photo upper left).

#### CLASS DESCRIPTION

Kathy will be teaching a nine-hour knitting workshop at the Ramada Inn in historic Ligonier, PA, with the topic *Twisted Knitting*. Travel back in time to 18th century Europe, to a valley located on the border of Austria and Germany, where the knitting tradition known as Twisted-Stitch Knitting was born. Resembling cables, Twisted-Stitch patterns comprise twisted knit stitches traveling diagonally across a purl background to create a captivatingly textured fabric.

In this class, you will learn about the origin and history of this tradition, characteristics of and methods for creating the stitches, and swatch several different stitch patterns. Traditional twisted-stitch patterns are represented graphically. This class takes a look at both historical representations of stitch patterns as well as current methods. You will learn all the skills you need to knit any charted twisted-stitches pattern, however, the *Bavarian Byways Beanie* project (shown page 8, lower right), which we will cast on and work in class, contains both written and charted instructions.

#### WEEKEND DETAILS

The weekend package includes an after-hours Soup & Sliders party and special shopping time at Kathy's Kreations (Friday evening); an informal meet & greet on Friday evening to get acquainted; an optional Friday evening knit-along; morning coffee breaks and two lunches at the Ramada; classes Saturday and Sunday; extended lunch break on Saturday with time to shop in the pretty little town of Ligonier and goodie bags (includes yarn for class project).

Registration is \$250 per person. Overnight lodging is not included and is optional for local participants. The Ramada has set up a special rate for us, so please make your own reservations by calling 724-238-9545.
