Cast on some summer! On our radar as warmer weather approaches are tee tops, tanks, lace shawls and the ever-popular portable project, socks. Do you find yourself falling back on simple stitches and simple shapes recently? You are not alone. Against the background of sustainability, DIY themes and "slow" fashion (designing and creating garments for quality and longevity) are very much in vogue. Plus, we are all increasingly involved in activities that we can do well from home. There's a whole lot of knitting (aka medknit-ation) and crocheting going on -- it somehow makes everything better!

New yarns are once more arriving and we are as excited as a kid on Christmas morning to see the UPS guy arrive with gorgeous hand-dyed yarns that are a sight to behold! DREAM IN COLOR has created 6 new colors in a cool, serene, inspired collection as their *Ode to Springtime: Evening Edition* (shown upper left). This combo set of "Smoochy with Cashmere" was designed to showcase the just-released wildly popular two-skein shawl pattern by Casapinka, *Breathe and Hope* (our May 2020 knit-along project see page 4). Pair one skein of the multi-color with any of the five cool semi-solids to knit the shawl (\$34.50 each, 4 ounces, 70% superwash merino / 20% cashmere/10% nylon, 400 yards, CYCA #2). DREAM IN COLOR's passion is to keep you delighted by offering a full range of long wearing, oh-so-soft yarns custom milled in North America and dyed to your order. They have almost two decades in the industry and continue to create new and awe-inspiring colors for your everyday inspiration. We can't wait to be able to show these spectacular colors in person! The *Ode to Springtime: Morning Edition* warm colors collection will be arriving later this spring...

Craving a refreshing summer-inspired colorway? EMMA'S YARN introduces their May 2020 Crazy Beautiful Club shade (shown lower right) along with co-ordinating colors. This minty color has fun pops of summer brights throughout. We have this shade available in three bases -- "Practically Perfect" sock, "Splendid Singles" fingering singly-ply, and "Simply Spectacular DK". Kathy is using "Splendid Singles" in colorways Kale and Foxy Lady for her *Breathe and Hope* knit along project. One thing we are craving during our stay at home are cozy socks. If you're up for a "sock hop", check out our new arrivals from EMMA'S YARNS. "Practically Perfect Sock" (\$26.95, 100 grams, 400 yards, 80-% superwash merino / 20% nylon, CYCA #2) is truly that -- the perfect fingering weight yarn for your new favorite pair of socks, or anything else you can think of! This 2-ply machine washable yarn has a little stretch in it making it great to work with a crazy comfortable pair of socks. Gorgeous new shades from the Crazy, Beautiful Club April 2020 (navy, red, green mix on a neutral background) and May 2020 (see page 2) are here -- you'll need just one for a pair of socks, but this yarn is also great in other garments like shawls and wraps. Never knit socks before? First-timers will find LISA KNITS "Boomerang Socks" pattern (\$5.00) beginner-friendly. Choose this basic adult size sock with a traditional German style heel shaping in either toe-up or cuff-down versions. If a heavier sock is more to your liking, LISA KNITS SK-030 "Katie's Farm Socks" (\$5.00, shown upper right) is worked toe-up in DK weight with a textured broken rib cuff and instep. We also have a large selection of knitting needles suitable for sock knitting in double-points, FlexiFlips, two circs and Magic loop from KNITTER'S PRIDE Karbonz and Dreamz, CLOVER bamboo, or BRITTANY birch. We also stock 6" double-point sock needle sets from LYKKE (\$102.00 driftwood birch, US sizes 0 - 5) and KNITTER'S PRIDE Dreamz (\$43.50 birch, US sizes 0 - 3) and KNITTER'S PRIDE Karbonz (\$84.00, US size 0 - 3). A new shipment of longer length FLEXIFLIPS in larger sizes has recently arrived (\$30.50, US sizes 7 - 11)...



PLYMOUTH "Encore Worsted" (\$6.95, 100 grams, 210 yards, 75% acrylic / 25% wool, CYCA #4) wool blend continues to be the preferred yarn for workhorse, washable projects. We've recently had increased requests for baby blanket projects, and "Encore" is just the ticket! Perfect for beginning and experienced knitters, this soft yarn offers a great value for the crafters that demand the highest quality yarns. Loved for the ability to be machine washed and machine dried, the extensive array of colors and proven dependability for decades. Did we mention that all in-stock shades are on sale this month?

There's something soothing about knitting uncomplicated projects like CHURCHMOUSE CLASSICS. *Lace Sampler Scarf* (\$8.50) is a generous rectangular scarf serving up three stunning lace patterns in a lightweight yarn. Each motif syncs up beautifully where they transition. This provides great practice for newbies wishing to improve their lace knitting skills or a relaxing walk in the park for more experienced knitters in search of a clever diversion. Both charts and written instructions are included. Follow the pattern as written or vary the amount of each stitch to taste.

*Pinking Shears Scarf* (\$6.50) features a fun little zigzag detail at the edges of a basic garter stitch scarf. The shallow triangle is worked "both ends against the middle" and is grafted for perfectly mirrored halves. Choose one of our lace or fingering yarns in wool or cool linen. Make a lavish wrap or a tiny kerchief -- the length is all up to you. This little accessory is perfect to wear all year 'round!

*Easy Eyelet Poncho & Wrap* (\$8.50, shown lower left). In possibly the simplest lace pattern that exists (it's a one-row repeat!), this breezy, multi-season layer is quick to knit. With more holes than yarn, it's almost instant gratification! Written in your choice of 2 gauges, knit it in DK or worsted! We recommend ROWAN *Creative Linen DK* (\$15.50, 100 grams, 50% linen / 50% cotton, CYCA #3) for season-spanning wear. Plant-based blends make the ideal blend for spring and summer, combining the best attributes of both fibers for coolness and hardiness, as well as giving us some airflow...





\*\*\* MAY 2020 KNIT-ALONG (KAL) \*\*\*

Thank you to our customers for all the support on what was supposed to be LYS DAY April 25, 2020. It was not as much fun without being able to see you in person, but we appreciate all the mail orders and curbside pick-ups!

Designer Casapinka made a huge impact on the knitting community with her *Breathe and Hope Shawl* pattern introduced for a "modified LYS DAY" (\$6.00 Ravelry Pro, shown upper left). It's such a beautiful project! We are

still taking orders as we have put together a handful of yarn combinations suitable for this project. You will need two complimentary 400 yard skeins of fingering weight yarn in two solids, two tonals, a tonal and a variegated, or a solid and a speckle. Pick two from our large selection of yarns (such as new arrivals from Dream In Color & Emma's Yarn) and cast on! You can order the pattern from us and we will have it downloaded into your Ravelry library.

Our continuing knitting class series based on books by Michelle Hunter and taught by instructor Karen McCullough continue. Take your knitting to the next level with new skills. *Building With Lace* has been postponed and re-scheduled for **Tuesday, June 2, 2020; 9:30 am - 12:30 pm** and focuses on *Nupps*. A nupp is a textured stitch with its origin in Estonian Lace. Nupp" (rhymes with "loop") is the Estonian word for "button" or "knob". Commonly worked into designs as berries or flower buds, nupps add old world charm and interest to any fabric. These bobble-like nubs grace the most sophisticated and envied of all lace patterns. Class registration is \$20.00 for the class plus purchase of book and yarn from Kathy's Kreations.

AND, improve your knitting skills one square at a time with *Building Blocks*, designed to help knitters navigate through major knitting techniques and principles. The recommended yarn is HiKOO "Simpliworsted", a lovely blend of superwash merino and premium acrylic/nylon that is very soft and durable. We continue the lessons by learning *Slip Stitch*. Unless otherwise stated, a stitch is slipped as if to purl with yarn in back (wyib). This allows the slip stitch to sit correctly on the right hand needle with the working yarn hidden on the wrong side. In this block however, all stitches are slipped as if purl with the working yarn held in front (wyif). Moving the working yarn to the front as you slip the stitch makes for an interesting and decorative design element, and is one of the (otherwise stated) exceptions to the slip stitch rule. The class is scheduled for **Tuesday, June 2, 2020, from 1:00 pm - 3:00 pm**. Registration fee is \$15.00 plus purchase of book and yarn from Kathy's Kreations...

\*\*\* ICELANDIC BIND-OFF \*\*\*

Step 1. K1; slip stitch from right needle to left needle purlwise.

Step 2. Insert right needle purlwise into first stitch on left needle, then knitwise into second stitch to catch front loop of second stitch.

Step 3. Draw front loop of second stitch through first stitch and knit it.

Step 4. Drop both stitches from left needle.

Repeat these 4 steps until all stitches are bound off.

\*\*\* SHAWL KNITTING TIP \*\*\*

When working an asymmetrical crescent-shaped shawl such as *Mindful* from our March knit along: If the top edge is too tight, make an extra yarn over at the beginning of each row. It will make the top edge more stretchy. It is not counted as a stitch and is dropped on the next row.

\*\*\* PENNSYLVANIA ROAD TRIP MYSTERY SHAWL KNIT-ALONG \*\*\*

A fun new knit-along among PA yarn shops (and beyond) kicked off on Saturday, April 25, 2020 and runs through the end of August! Your "tour guides" are Cynthia Spencer of REALLY CLEAR DESIGNS / STITCH YOUR ART OUT and her techy friend Valerie Reed who have designed an exciting new shawl that you can combine with retail therapy by visiting local yarn shops when health safety concerns permit! They are both experienced knitters with a love of beautiful yarn, local yarn shops, and the wonderful community of people that share our love of knitting. They have decided to take inspiration from the things they have seen and experienced while living and traveling in their home state of Pennsylvania to make a stunning shawl with a variety of stitch patterns. Every stitch pattern they've included is inspired by a shape or pattern or color they've seen in the beauty that surrounds us all.



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Kathy's Kreations

Cynthia writes: "It's the first in what I hope will be many road-trip mystery shawls. This one's called Pennsylvania Road Trip. We've had so much fun thinking about all the places in PA we'll be 'visiting' as we work the clues of the shawl. Although we were inspired by PA locations, I promise you that the stitch patterns will look good in any part of the knitting universe! (Also, it's fun to learn about PA's quirks no matter where you live. We'll be covering the state from yinz to wudder.)

We're going to award prizes at each clue for customers who take photos of their shawls at any LYS. Our project uses fingering weight yarn and Kathy's Kreations will special order kits for you from MEADOWCROFT DYEWORKS. You can view the colorway options at the road trip mystery website. There has been an unusually high demand for the kits. The guys at MEADOWCROFT DYEWORKS have been working hard to accommodate and fulfill the many requests. We will be doing this fun project as spring and summer progresses, as it will take place over several weeks. The "Start Your Engines" segment has begun with a simple garter stitch edging (kit PA RAILROADS, shown upper right). You may also select fingering weight yarn from our collection in four different colors. Colors A and D are bold/dark colors that look different from each other in color but are the same intensity. C is a medium/light color, and B is a variegated or speckled yarn that coordinates with or ties together all the other yarns. You will need 400 yards of each color.

This project was designed so that the pattern stitches are always interchangeable. You have nearly unlimited possibilities for how your shawl will look! Choose based on your mood of the moment, your desire to learn a new technique, or whatever reason you'd like. It's your shawl! Each leg will contain two options for the next section of the shawl (one designed by Cynthia, the other by Valerie), setting up every knitter for a grand choose-your-own knitting adventure. You may choose between Valerie's option or Cynthia's. Optional beads will be added in the May 8, 2020 leg of our journey. We have a large selection of MIYUKI glass beads for this project as well as tiny steel crochet hooks for placing the beads in your work.

Cynthia and Valerie have designed a lovely shawl with a variety of stitch patterns inspired by the sights and wonders of PA. The trusses of a bridge, a beautiful flower, the winding trail up ahead -- just about anything can be inspiration for making something beautiful. Each option is a creative tribute to a national landmark, historical event, or region that can be encountered on a Road Trip around the great Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. So what's the mystery? Where we'll go next, of course!

Whether you stop in to take a class or visit us during the PA Mystery Shawl Road Trip when we are able to re-open once restrictions are lifted, Ligonier Country Market or Night Market, a Girls' Day Out Trip, the Steel Valley Yarn Crawl, or for a much-needed mini-getaway later this summer or fall, we think Ligonier is a happening place and always like a refreshing step back in time!

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\*\*\* GAIL'S SCARF \*\*\*

Mohair is all the rage right now. Whether held single, double, or in combination with another yarn, mohair mania is having a moment.

We love hearing about the projects you've been making while under stay-at-home orders. Gail G shared her beautiful scarf design (shown lower left; stitch detail upper right) and has generously granted permission for us to re-print the pattern for all of you. Gail unexpectedly acquired her friend's yarn stash. She chose to use a lovely worsted weight merino/silk in combination with a multi-colored mohair blend to make this beautiful scarf. She tells us that she used the crochet Chinese waitress cast on because she liked the edge it creates. At the end, she knit one row plain to avoid binding off yarn overs and then used the Icelandic bind-off (see page 4) because it most resembles the Chinese waitress cast-on (technique given below). Thank you, Gail!

FINISHED MEASUREMENT: 8" X 53"

GAUGE: 4 sts = 1" (not critical)

MATERIALS: Approximately 200 yards each worsted weight yarn and mohair carry-along yarn;  
US size 10 knitting needles; tapestry needle for weaving in ends.

NOTE: The scarf is knit double-stranded with one strand each of a mohair and a worsted weight yarn

PATTERN STITCH

All rows: \*K1, yarn over, knit 2 together; repeat from \* across row.

DIRECTIONS

Cast on 24 sts. Work in pattern stitch until piece measures 53" or until just enough yarn is left to bind off.

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\*\*\* CHINESE WAITRESS CAST ON \*\*\*

This is a great cast on when you need it very stretchy. Besides scarves, it's perfect for socks, legwarmers, turtlenecks and the bottoms of sweaters.

Step 1. Make a slip knot and put on your knitting needle. NOTE: This stitch does not count.

Step 2. Put the crochet hook in FRONT of the working yarn and BEHIND the knitting needle. Wind the yarn under the hook and around the needle.

Step 3. Rotate the crochet hook so it's facing left. Snag the yarn and pull it through. 1 stitch cast on and 1 loop on hook. Continue this step until you have one less than the number you need. REMEMBER -- the slip knot does not count.

Step 4. Bring the yarn under the needle and to the left of the hook. Put the loop on the knitting needle. This last part is different since it's the last stitch. Place this final loop on the knitting needle.

Step 5. Remember that the slip knot DOES NOT COUNT. Your final step is to slide that slip knot off the needle and tug on the yarn to pullout.

### \*\*\* FALL FLING WEEKEND 2020 \*\*\*

Kathy's Kreations invites you to join us our 11th annual "Fall Fling" Knitting Workshop Weekend, to be held **October 2 - 4, 2020**, hosted by Kathy Zimmerman. We are delighted to announce that TKGGA-certified Master Knitter and Technical Editor, Kathy Erhard of Export, PA will be our featured instructor (Kathy's photo upper left).

#### CLASS DESCRIPTION

Kathy will be teaching a nine-hour knitting workshop at the Ramada Inn in historic Ligonier, PA, with the topic *Twisted Knitting*. Travel back in time to 18th century Europe, to a valley located on the border of Austria and Germany, where the knitting tradition known as Twisted-Stitch Knitting was born. Resembling cables, Twisted-Stitch patterns comprise twisted knit stitches traveling diagonally across a purl background to create a captivatingly textured fabric.

In this class, you will learn about the origin and history of this tradition, characteristics of and methods for creating the stitches, and swatch several different stitch patterns. Traditional twisted-stitch patterns are represented graphically. This class takes a look at both historical representations of stitch patterns as well as current methods. You will learn all the skills you need to knit any charted twisted-stitches pattern, however, the *Bavarian Byways Beanie* project (shown lower right), which we will cast on and work in class, contains both written and charted instructions.

#### WEEKEND DETAILS
